



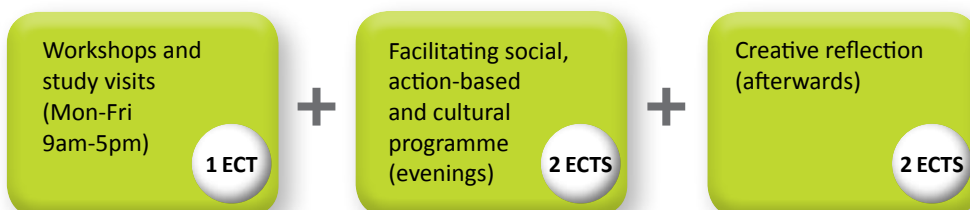
CREATIVITY AND LEARNING, SUMMER SCHOOL
